
Developing sustainable water infrastructure

WaterConnect complements the existing strengths of co-developers by sharing project development costs and providing technical expertise in resilience, social and environmental impact, and project structuring. We develop projects from concept to financial close to increase the volume of investable opportunities and catalyze the flow of capital toward the sector.

Bridging the infrastructure investment gap with project preparation

Capital remains the greatest barrier to solving the water crisis. Investors are hesitant to invest in early-stage water and sanitation infrastructure projects due to the risks and complexities of project development which leads to a shortage of investment-ready assets. WaterConnect seeks to address this gap by developing a bankable pipeline of well-prepared water and sanitation infrastructure projects. By sharing project development cost and risk with our partners while providing complementary technical expertise, we can accelerate the availability of investmentready project opportunities. We focus on both public and private projects that increase access to water and sanitation services, improve freshwater quality, or address water scarcity, all of which build water resilience for households and watersheds.
